Our Guest Artist This Month-Véronique Duplain



Day 28 - Selfenvol

Véronique Duplain is a self-taught multidisciplinary artist who lives and works in Montreal. In recent years, she has explored different spheres of photography and scenography.

It stands out in particular with its world of bright colors, its assumed eclectic post-modern style and its images and installations with an elaborate narrative. Its approach is motivated by a voluntary imposition of creative constraints which push the development of new processes such as the ntegration of cutting-edge technologies such as robotics and 3D printing in its mediums of creative expression.

Véronique left a career in management aside in 2016 to invest full time in the visual world. Through her solo exhibitions in the Gallery, notably 4 years in a row at Arsenal Art Contemporain (2019-2022), she continues to work hard on increasingly ambitious projects.

Her projects have been presented at various festivals from Montreal to Berlin, and his works are part of various public and private collections. For her, art is a playground to explore, she has not finished showing us all the colors!
